

MODERN SPORTS SPECIAL REGULATIONS

The Fédération Française de Sport Automobile (F.F.S.A) has established standard regulations applicable in all French rallies. The 32nd Charlemagne Golden Palace Rally is organized according to these provisions. These special regulations specify and supplement the standard F.F.S.A regulations for French rallies. The articles not included in these regulations are in conformity with the articles of the standard regulations

Recommendations to Ladies and Gentlemen Competitors

It is thanks to the understanding of the Mayors of the municipalities crossed by the Rallye Charlemagne - Golden Palace, and of the city of Hautmont, that we have been able to build this 32nd edition.

However, it is thanks to your sportsmanship and the responsible attitude that you will be able to adopt during reconnaissance and the weekend of the race, that the sustainability of this event can be ensured. We therefore ask you to scrupulously respect the rules of traffic and the Highway Code, and to cross inhabited areas at an appropriate speed.

We remind you that reconnaissance is limited in number of days of reconnaissance and in number of passages; they are only tolerated from the weekend preceding the rally and the defined time slots. Apart from these, any recognition is prohibited.

Controls will be carried out jointly by the Gendarmerie, by the Police and by us. No tolerance, no indulgence will be granted to offenders.

We are counting on your understanding, on the elegance of your attitude and your behavior depends the future of our event and of rallies in general.

1.2P. ELIGIBILITY

The 32nd Charlemagne Golden Palace Rally is on the national calendar. It counts for:

- The 2024 French Rally Cup (coef. 3),
- The Hauts de France League Championships.
- The ASA 59 Hautmont Challenges.

1.3P. CHECKS

ANY CREW REGULARLY ENTERED WILL RECEIVE A PERSONAL SUMMONS, BY WHICH THE CREW WILL BE INVITED TO REPORT FOR CHECKS ON FRIDAY SEPTEMBER 29, 2023 AT THE TIME INDICATED TO THEM.

- Only racing vehicles will be allowed to enter the scrutineering area.
- The list of convocation times will be published on the ASA 59 website, www.asa59-hautmont.com/rallye-charlemagne
- Administrative checks: 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.: Citroën Maubeuge D649 - Feignies

Scrutineering: from 6:15 p.m. to 10:15 p.m. Citroën Maubeuge D649 - Feignies

Any final checks will take place at the Garage on avenue Leclercq 59330 Hautmont.

The hourly labor rate is set at €60 including tax.

ARTICLE 3P. COMPETITORS AND DRIVERS

3.1P. ENTRY REQUEST – REGISTRATION

3.1.5P. Any competitor wishing to participate in the Charlemagne Golden Palace rally must send the attached entry form, duly completed, to the rally secretariat (postmark as proof), before September 18, 2023 at midnight.

3.1.10P. The number of entries for the 32nd Rallye Charlemagne Golden Palace is set at a maximum of 140 cars. In the event that the number of entrants for the 6th Charlemagne Golden Palace VHC Rally (20 cars) and the 5th Charlemagne VHRS Golden Palace Rally (20 cars) is not reached, the number of entrants for the 32nd Charlemagne Rally will be increased without however exceed 180 cars.

3.1.11.1P. The entry fees are fixed:

- with the organizers' optional advertising: €556
- without the organizers' optional advertising: €1,106

Deduction of €6 on each commitment for the Commissaires of the Ligue des Hauts de France.

5% discount on entry if an ASA-59 licensee on board, and 10% if full ASA-59 crew.

ARTICLE 4P. CARS AND EQUIPMENT

4.3P. ASSISTANCE

Compliant with standard FFSA regulations.

Assistance vehicle entries will be made during the following time slots:

- Friday, September 29: from 8:00 a.m. (placement by the organization)

Only one vehicle per crew will be allowed to enter the service park, specific stickers must imperatively be put on the windshield.

Only vehicle exits at the end of the stage are authorized, any exit during the stage is final.

NB: A plateau park is organized, its address will be communicated when taking the road book. The organization cannot be held responsible in the event of theft or damage.

4.8 : GPS

The implementation of geolocation must be regarded as a mandatory security measure in the same way as a harness or other. It is therefore mandatory.

Throughout the duration of the rally, the cars must be equipped with a tracer which will be given to them at the administrative control before the Rally, against a deposit (by check of €200).

They will be activated at the exit of the start park of the event (by an official)

This deposit will be returned when the tracers are returned, except in the case where the tracer is not returned within the time indicated and 50€ of administrative costs will then be collected.

In the event of abandonment, the track setters must be returned to the rally headquarters, or failing that, handed over to an event official. If this is not possible, the plotters must be returned by colissimo the day after the event at the latest, to the following address:

The league undertakes to return the deposit, even in the event of total or partial destruction of the tracer following an accident occurring during the rally.

No rental is expected. Operating costs are borne by the organizer and the league. Fixing hardware will be provided. After the rally, this plate will not be taken back and may be used for other events.

There is no need to provide a connection, these tracers being self-powered for the entire duration of the rally.

Throughout the duration of the rally, any competitor surprised by not having his tracer in place will be sanctioned by the college of stewards, a sanction which may go as far as exclusion.

ARTICLE 6P. SITES AND INFRASTRUCTURES

6.1P. DESCRIPTION

The 32nd Charlemagne Golden Palace Rally represents a course of 327.360 km. It is divided into 2 stages and 4 sections.

It has 5 different special stages and 10 in total, with a length of 138.500 km.

The special stages are:

6.2P. RECONNAISSANCES

6.2.1P

The maximum number of passages authorized by E.S. will be 3.

6.2.2P. Cars

Reconnaissance can only be carried out with the vehicle declared on the entry form. This vehicle will be standard, without roll cage, without tires other than those approved for the road and without means of intercommunication.

Stickers, provided by the organisation, identified as 'RALLYE CHARLEMAGNE RECONNAISSANCE + serial number', must be affixed in the places defined when the route book is handed over, throughout the reconnaissance period.

6.2.5P Duration

Recce will take place on September 23, 24 & 29, 2023 from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Outside of these days and time slots above, any reconnaissance is prohibited.

to report abandonments or report an accident.

7.5.18P COMPETITOR SAFETY

Tracers are equipped with a "panic" button. This button can only be used for a request for serious medical assistance, excluding any other request. By pressing this button, the competitor must be aware that the E.S. will be stopped and help will be dispatched immediately.

If this point is not respected, the competitor incurs a request for disciplinary action from the FFSA. Deposit check payable to Genesis Sport

7.5.20P Trial session

Compliant with standard FFSA rally regulations

A test session, on a secure closed road, will be organized on Friday September 28, from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Competitors wishing to participate must make a request when they enter, the participation fee is set at €40 per crew and per car.

The crew must be in racing attire. The car must display the distinctive stickers of the practice session, their locations will be indicated when taking the road books as well as the place of unloading of the racing cars. At the start of the practice session, a scrutineer will check at least the conformity of the safety equipment of the cars and the crews. The organizer reserves the right to cancel this session if the number of registrants is less than 20.
